









# Award for best Students work in the field of Non-destructive Testing (NDT)

The Swiss Society for Non-destructive Testing - SSNT donates a prize for outstanding student work with a total value of 3'600.- CHF, for student activities performed in the field of non-destructive testing (NDT). The prize money will be awarded as a training voucher for the advanced course required to achieve NDT Level 3 certification in an industry sector of your choice, such as industrial manufacturing, railways, or aviation.

The prize is awarded in memory of **Mr. René Hornung** and is intended to encourage young researchers to become actively involved in the exciting field of Non-destructive Testing.

The selection committee consists of experienced researchers and practical users from the field of NDT.

### **Conditions for participation:**

- Work must focus on Non-destructive Applications,
- Student theses, Final theses, Bachelor-, Master-, or PhD theses,
- Individuals or teams,
- Participants have not yet reached the age of 30,
- Participants must be enrolled at a Swiss University.

### **Examples of possible projects:**

- NDT application for the industry,
- NDT for the Aerospace or the Railway industry,
- NDT fit for the future (NDT 4.0),
- Artificial Intelligent for NDT applications,
- Remote controlled NDT inspections,
- etc.
